The South County Area Plans Review process provides an opportunity to suggest amendments to the Comprehensive Plan for the Mount Vernon Magisterial District .

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Charrette is to provide a concise vehicle for stakeholders within the Mount Vernon District to weigh in on changes and/or modifications to the Comprehensive plan for the Mount Vernon Council of Citizens Associations (MVCCA) Long Range Strategic Planning Committee (LRSPC) as it creates it's APR nominations. Given the short time available to submit nominations for plan revisions, the Charrette process allows for a maximum amount of input and participation in a focused environment. This process will be used to solicit input from a broad and diverse group of people concerned about the character and development of their district. This input will be used by the MVCCA as it formulate it's APR nominations.

**PROCESS:** Participants will be formed into work groups. They will then move into a table rotation process where each table (eight in total) will have a District Planning Sector Map with the sites the MVCCA LRSPC has identified for feedback and possible nomination. Each table will be facilitated. The facilitators will provide their group with some considerations relating to the properties that the group may want to discuss. The groups will also have an opportunity to suggest other changes to other sites in the specific Planning Sectors and give feedback on the current sites the MVCCA LRSPC is considering for nomination. Every twenty minutes, the groups will rotate tables until every group has had a chance to comment on all of the sites in each of the planning sectors. After that step, the MVCCA LRSPC will review all feedback provided as it drafts it's APR nominations.
