Embark Richmond Highway is a multi-year effort involving land use and transportation planning, design and construction activities that will result in a bus rapid transit (BRT) system along with a connected network of roads, sidewalks, trails and bike facilities. The BRT will operate primarily on dedicated lanes along Richmond Highway initially from the Huntington Metrorail Station to Fort Belvoir. The project will also include a future extension of the Metrorail Yellow Line to Hybla Valley.
