- Virginia has 14,000 lane miles 11,000 of which are secondary roads.
- Presently 30% of roads are considered to be in good shape; expect that to rise to 45% by end of the year.

Next year's schedule May-Oct


Finish current year

Mt Vernon Streets to be repaved and restriped in 2019


Criteria for choosing what gets paved:

- 1. Pavement Condition
- 2. Traffic volume
- 3. Neighborhoods done collectively
- 4. Economies of scale
- 5. Feedback from maintenance crews, public, supervisors
- Requires significant coordination with water, gas, electric, schools, others.
- No changes to schedules.
- Can't predict precise street schedule
- Three days prior street signs posted (No Parking).
- Crews typically work on neighborhood streets weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What is proposed to change this year with new striping

Note: Bike lanes are getting a great deal of attention, safety, public desire, rising number of cyclist fatalities.

Mount Vernon District Information

Boston Boulevard: FCDOT and VDOT are proposing to add bike lanes in both directions. On-street parking will be maintained where currently allowed.

Edinburgh Drive: FCDOT and VDOT are proposing to stripe parking lanes and line the median with a yellow line.

Fullerton Road between Rolling Road and
Boston Boulevard: FCDOT and VDOT are
proposing to redesign the road as a two-lane road



Lorton Station Boulevard: FCDOT and VDOT are proposing to convert the outside lanes into either on-street parking lanes with bike lanes or into buffered bike lanes, depending on community feedback (Hudson Farm Road, pictured).

Northumberland Road: FCDOT and VDOT are proposing to stripe bike lanes or shared lane markings, depending on the width of the road and community on-street parking needs. Onstreet parking will be maintained on both sides of the street in front of street-facing residences and at the elementary school. Where on-street parking on both sides is not needed (for example, near the utility corridor), a northbound parking land and bike lanes in both directions are proposed. Residents are encouraged to provide input on which parking areas should be maintained.



Vernon View Drive between Bushrod Road and Teresa Ann Court: FCDOT and VDOT are proposing to center the center line and stripe parking lanes on both sides of the road.
