- ✓ Work with government officials and elected representatives to demonstrate leadership in environmental stewardship, wise land use, highest quality education, and efficient transportation systems,.
- ✓ Work with government officials and elected representatives to ensure adequate, workable, and available support services are provided for the residents with fewer resources, including services in public health, mental health, juvenile intervention and affordable housing options.
- ✓ Maintain an ongoing dialog with elected officials expressing our expectations for education, recreation, safety, libraries, transportation, the environment, human services, and historic and neighborhood preservation.
- ✓ Promote policies that increase economic opportunities and support an attractive mix of businesses in the District.
